On May 26, 2016 at 12:50 pm the Evert Police Department, Chief Beam, was dispatched to an armed robbery call at First Merit Bank in Evert. Also responding were units from the Osceola County Sheriff's Office and Michigan State Police. Information received from the bank indicated a male subject had robbed the bank using what appeared to be a handgun then left on foot. The Evert Police Department received additional information prior to the armed robbery call regarding a truck driving recklessly through the Middle School parking lot. The information was then relayed to other responding units. It was on 80th Ave. where deputies first observed the suspect vehicle and attempted to make a traffic stop. The suspect vehicle failed to stop - starting a pursuit lasting approximately five miles that ended on 70th Ave. near 17 mile where the suspect vehicle stopped on its own. Deputies were then able to secure the two occupants of the vehicle. Further investigation at the scene and from information gathered at the bank, resulted in both subjects, a 54 year old male and 29 year old female being arrested and transported to the Osceola County Jail. Evert Police Chief Beam along with detectives from the Osceola County Sheriff's Office and Michigan State Police continued to investigate the scene at the bank.

After the initial dispatch call that the suspect was on foot, Evert Police notified the Evert Public Schools to be placed on lock-down. The lock down was lifted after suspects were taken into custody.

This investigation was a joint operation between the Evert Police Department and assisting agencies: Osceola County Sheriff's Office and Michigan State Police.

The suspects were arraigned on May 27, 2016 and were identified as Melissa Nudd and David Dingee.
