The department was contacted by Mr. Peacock to conduct an evaluation of the students reactions to an active shooter. A mock-active shooter scenario was conducted. Also in attendance were the Evart fire department. Evaluation included how the students would react in the event should a situation like this occur. Evacuation points were determined. The students took the drills seriously and it opened dialog between them and the departments on how to handle the situation.

Chief Backing attended the LETR (Law Enforcement Torch Run) Held in Acme, MI. The conference focused on involvement in the Special Olympics. Sergeant Beam will be participating in a polar plunge the middle of next month in Rockford to raise awareness for the cause.


OTHER CITABLE OFFENSES
