### **City of Ewart – Charter Amendment Proposal No. 1:**

Shall the Charter, of the City of Ewart, be amended, by amending Sections 3.7; 4.1; 4.3; 4.10; 6.1; & 6.4, to change the Ewart City Clerk, from an elected position, elected by the City Electors, to an appointed position, appointed by the City Council, to take effect in November, 2020, or upon a vacancy, in that office, whichever occurs first?

### **City of Ewart – Charter Amendment Proposal No. 2:**

Shall the Charter, of the City of Ewart, be amended, by amending Section 4.14, to change the number of regular meetings, per month, from at least twice, to at least once?

### **City of Ewart – Charter Amendment Proposal No. 3:**

Shall the Charter, of the City of Ewart, be amended, by amending Section 8.16, to change the date, for the final payment of City Taxes, prior to late penalty, from August 10<sup>th</sup>, to September 15<sup>th</sup>, of each year?

**City of Evert – Public Safety Millage:**

Shall the City of Evert be authorized to levy 1.8 Mills (\$1.80 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) from 2019 to 2022, inclusive, a period of four (4) years, for the purpose of defraying, in part, the cost of current operations of the Evert Police Department. The estimated revenue that will be collected in the first year, December 2019, is estimated to be \$53,178.24 based on the 2018 taxable valuation. This millage is not a renewal but will replace the current approved public safety millage which levies 1.8 Mills, which expires 12-31-2018?
